



CASE STUDY

Engineer Dispatch

Eliminates man-hour shortages in equipment maintenance

Case of a semiconductor equipment manufacturer. By dispatching full-time engineers produced from Nisso's own education and training facilities, the company was able to resolve a shortage of human resources for manufacturing equipment maintenance and preservation work and achieve a high retention rate.



Customer Concerns

- Difficulty in securing human resources to take on manufacturing equipment maintenance tasks.
- Staffing firms specializing in the engineering business are expensive.
- 03 Retirement during the education period is a major challenge.

Effects of Service Introduction

- 01 Eliminate human resource shortages in manufacturing equipment maintenance and preservation operations.
- 02 Achieve cost reductions
- 03 High retention rate

By dispatching full-time engineers produced from our own education and training facilities, we have eliminated the shortage of human resources for manufacturing equipment maintenance and preservation work. Compared to personnel agencies specializing in engineers, costs were significantly reduced by training and dispatching personnel pinpointing the processes in which they are needed. By supporting the dispatched permanent engineers with highly specialized members, we were able to achieve a high retention rate.

Manufacturing Dispatch

Improved fusing rate contributes to cost reduction and productivity improvement

Case of an electronic components manufacturer with offices throughout Japan. Utilizing Nisso's skilled employees (regular employees) has improved retention rates and productivity.



Customer Concerns

- Rapid business expansion, utilization of outside personnel exceeds 8,000 nationwide, and retention rate is unstable.
- O2 Chronic and heavy burden of personnel replacement and turnover.

Effects of Service Introduction

- 31 Significantly improved and more stable fusing rate.
- 02 Reduced replacement costs and greatly improved productivity.

With the introduction of Nisso's permanent (skilled) worker dispatch service, the number of new hires and retention rate increased significantly, as more people wanted to work for Nisso's over the long term. The lead time for recruitment was shortened and production loss was reduced.

The improved retention rate has reduced the number of replacements, including replenishment, and reduced proficiency losses, resulting in reduced recruitment costs and increased productivity.

Manufacturing Outsourcing

Outsourced mechanical design work

Case of a production equipment manufacturer. By utilizing NISSO's outsourced contracting services, operations were consolidated and production efficiency increased.



Customer Concerns

- O1 Large coordination costs due to the need to separate work and request multiple outside vendors.
- 1 want to start a new business, but I don't have enough man-hours.

Effects of Service Introduction

- 01 Reduction of adjustment costs by consolidating Nisso's contracting services into a single contractor.
- Expanded Scope of Contracted Work Further Reduces Customer Burden.

The client's burden has been reduced by Nisso's centralized contracting of work that previously had to be performed in detail by multiple outside contractors. In addition, a leader was appointed, experienced personnel were hired, trainees were trained, and a system was put in place to ensure ongoing operations. In addition, the scope of contracted work was expanded, thereby reducing the burden on the client. The client was able to start working on new tasks and production efficiency was greatly improved.

Manufacturing Al Solutions

Detecting abnormalities in product defects by introducing Al

Case of a manufacturer of manufacturing equipment. Al was introduced to the work of conducting all inspections with a product visual inspection machine. Zero defective products were missed, over-detection rate of less than 3% was achieved, and inspectors were made more efficient.



Customer Concerns

- 01 Visual inspection work is difficult and inspectors are not retained.
- The inspection process is being automated, but there are many over-detections.
 - Lack of expertise and inability to take the plunge into Al

Effects of Service Introduction

- O1 Al tools specialized for the image domain enable highly accurate detection of defective products.
- O2 Suppresses over-detection of quality and gray areas where it is difficult to determine good or bad.
- Reduced manpower requirements for secondary inspection personnel.

Eliminates defective products from being passed on to subsequent processes by eliminating the possibility of missing defective products. By controlling over-detection, the number of secondary inspection personnel has been reduced.

In addition, even inexperienced employees can now easily make good/fail judgments, and the lower level of difficulty in the work has improved the retention rate. The company was also able to achieve benefits in terms of human resource development and technology transfer.
